

GDPR Privacy Policy

In compliance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of physical persons with regard to the processing of personal data and the free circulation of such data (GDPR), we inform you that, by accepting this Privacy Policy, the user (hereinafter the "User") is informed and gives his free, informed, specific and unambiguous consent for the personal data provided through the Web page located at the URL <http://www.https://sa.agr.hr/>, (hereinafter, the "Website") to be treated by University of Zagreb Faculty of Agriculture hereinafter, "Faculty of Agriculture")

2.- Purposes of Data Processing

Faculty of Agriculture processes your personal data to ensure an adequate organization, follow-up, communication and promotion of conference 59th Croatian & 19th International Symposium on Agriculture, which will take place from 11th until 16th February 2024 in Dubrovnik, Croatia.

The data controller is Faculty of Agriculture, who is responsible for the overall organisation of the event, the communication with participants before and after the end of the event, as well as communication and promotion of the event.

The purpose of the processing of your personal data is handling registration and attendance, reporting on the event, as well as event follow-up actions, such as sharing presentations among participants and feedback collection. It includes, in particular, lists and mailing lists for contacts, invitations, participants, reports, minutes, distribution of reports/minutes, feedback on reports, meeting follow-up, follow-up meetings, follow-up actions, photographs/pictures, presentations, audio and/or video recording of speakers and participants, news and publications, managing requests for information about our services from the users, as well as allowing them to contact us for the contracting of services in the sector of organization of congresses, offered on the website.

Your personal data will not be used for an automated decision-making including profiling.

3.- Categories of personal data collected

When a User connects to this website, and sends their contact information through the Contact Form, they are providing personal information for which Faculty of Agriculture is responsible. This information includes: name, surname, institution, city, address, country, postal code, email address and telephone number.

Please note that there will be photos and audio and/or video recordings taken during the event based on the prior consent of the speakers and the participants given by accepting this Privacy policy. These photos may be published by Faculty of Agriculture for communication purposes.

By providing this information, you as a User give consent for your information to be collected, used, managed and stored by Faculty of Agriculture, only as described in this Privacy Policy.

4.- Conservation - how long do we keep your data?

Personal data is kept as long as follow-up actions to the event are necessary with regard to the purpose(s) of the processing of personal data as well as for the event and its related management. All data will be kept according to the legal terms established by the regulations that may be applicable.

5.- Legitimation

The legal basis for the processing of your data is the consent that is required by this privacy policy.

6.- Recipients - who has access to your information and to whom is it disclosed?

Access to your data is granted only to Faculty of Agriculture and its staff, who are involved in the organisation of the event. Where necessary, we may also share your information with service providers for the purposes of organising the event.

Faculty of Agriculture will not make any assignment, except to the organizing entity or due to legal obligation, nor any transfer of the data it receives.

7.- User Rights

You can exercise the rights of access, rectification, cancellation, opposition, forgetting and portability, as well as to withdraw the consent. Any request to exercise one of those rights should be directed to Faculty of Agriculture as the controller:

The user also has the right to effective judicial protection and to submit a claim to the supervisory authority, in this case, Croatian Personal Data Protection Agency (azop.hr), if they consider that the processing of personal data violates these regulations.

8.- Origin of the data

All the personal data we gather and process comes directly from the user through the website's forms (and cookies) when they fill these out and give their consent.

9.- Safety and Security

Faculty of Agriculture complies with the guidelines of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data (GDPR), as well as the Organic Law on Data Protection and other regulations in force at any given time, and ensures the correct use and treatment of the user's personal data.

In order to protect your personal data, a number of technical and organisational measures have been put in place. Technical measures include appropriate actions to address online security, risk of data loss, alteration of data or unauthorised access, taking into consideration the risk presented by the processing and the nature of the data being processed. Organisational measures include restricting access to the data to authorised persons with a legitimate need to know for the purposes of this processing operation.
